The signature history must also show the individuals' email addresses and IP address. of the governing body. • The preparer of the application is responsible for obtaining board signatures that comply with the requirement in Section 29-1-604 (3), C.R.S., that states the application shall be personally reviewed, approved, and signed by a majority of the members

The application for exemption from audit form created by our office includes a section for governing body approval. Local governing boards note their approval and submit the application through one of the following three methods:
1) Submit the application in hard copy via the US Mail including original signatures.

Office of the State Auditor staff will not coordinate obtaining signatures.

2) Submit the application electronically via email and either

a. Include a copy of an adopted resolution that documents formal approval by the Board, or b. Include electronic signatures obtained through a software program such as Docusign or Echosign in accordance with the requirements noted above.
